A Note from the Head Teacher

School Crossing Patrol Service

As you may be aware, the County Council is very reluctantly proposing to no longer fund a school crossing patrol service in a bid to help close a £35m shortfall in their budget next year, something which legally they must do.

This service is hugely valued by schools and parents and as part of the proposals the council are hoping communities will step forward and take on the funding of as many patrols as possible from September 2019.

A public consultation with the aim of gathering views and also generating ideas for funding is now open. A fundraising pack for communities will be available on our website. The costs would be in the region of £4,000 per year.

More details will be available on the council website here . The consultation runs until 31 December, 2018.

The road outside our school is dangerous and we need to ensure that a crossing patrol is in place for the safety of our children. Do please make your voice heard in the consultation and consider how the Hazel Slade community can support this vital service.


