You will notice that all the children are bringing home a Reading Record, this is for the children to fill in to show their continued reading at home and in school. The children should be aiming for 20 minutes an evening reading at home on top of the reading they do in school.

All the children in the school will be receiving spellings as homework linked to their ages and stages of learning; this is to support their word recognition and writing progress. This will begin during this half term. The upper school pupils will also receive some English and Maths homework; all homework is given to support and extend pupils knowledge and learning and I hope you will all continue to support your children with this.

Reading remains a focus for all with an aim for 20 minutes a day at home to compliment the reading done in school.

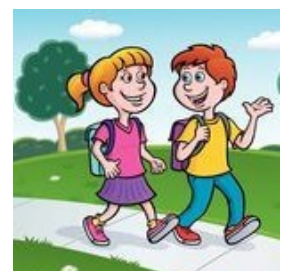


End of the day pick up.
